Triumphant Delivers Zero-Day Malware Protection With Breakthrough Technology

Triumphant Resolution Manager Enables Users to Stop Unknown Desktop Threats and Remove All Remnants of an Attack

Rockville, MD - February 24, 2009 -- Triumphant®, the industry pioneer in applying granular change detection to identifying and remediating malicious software, today announced a first-of-its-kind anti-malware solution that provides organizations with protection from zero-day attacks. Until now, traditional anti-virus solutions have been ineffective at identifying zero-day attacks. Triumphant changes this by using proprietary technology to monitor for malicious changes on the desktop, protecting against the vast majority of both known and unknown threats.

“By nature, any security solution that only looks for known threats is always going to fall behind the attacks, which is why Triumphant takes an entirely different approach, using granular change detection to monitor modifications on the desktop,” said Jim Ivers, Chief Marketing Officer at Triumphant. “As attacks continue to become more prevalent and sophisticated, Triumphant provides our customers with the ability to quickly detect the attacks that evade signature based software and remediate the problem to stop the attack and repair the damage done to the computer.”

Triumphant Resolution Manager uses its patent-pending analytics to identify unexpected changes and conditions in the desktop environment that indicate an attack. This is accomplished by tracking and analyzing over 200,000 attributes for every computer including registry keys, security settings, port settings, and performance statistics. These attributes are collected into the Triumphant adaptive reference model that detects changes at the granular level of each machine. The Resolution Manager determines if these changes are normal to the computer population or an anomalous event that is consistent with the behaviors and structures of malicious applications. By looking for these changes rather than the actual malware, Triumphant is able to identify zero-day malware long before traditional signature-based anti-virus solutions are even looking for it.

When an attack is discovered, Triumphant identifies the components of the suspected malware, the threat level it represents and initiates a remediation to remove the malicious code. Triumphant then goes beyond the traditional anti-malware approach of just removing the offending program and actually cleans up all artifacts associated with the attack. By tracking a comprehensive set of machine attributes, Triumphant is able to conduct holistic and surgical remediation, ensuring that there are no vulnerabilities created by altered configuration settings, open ports, or other damage.

In addition to protecting against malware attacks, Triumphant Resolution Manager monitors an organization’s desktops to make sure that all security policies and controls are enforced across the organization and that endpoint security software is properly installed and configured as well as operational. Triumphant closes a critical gap in the perimeter by detecting the threats that evade traditional signature based security software. The unique capabilities of the Triumphant platform make it a critical last line of defense.
